

Abuse case against Casey dropped

THE FORMER Bishop of Galway, Eamonn Casey, has described his "utter and absolute relief" after being told on Monday that he will not face any charges in connection with allegations that he sexually abused a child more than 30 years ago.

Dr Casey, who was a chaplain in the Diocese of Arundel and Brighton, stood down from pastoral duties at Our Lady of Fatima

in Staplefield, Sussex, in November last year when the complaint was first made public. With the permission of Bishop Martin Drennan he took up residence in the presbytery of the south Galway parish of Beagh in Shanaglish, where he has not been involved in parish duties.

Dr Casey, who is 79, will now undergo a church investigation to decide whether he can return to parish life. This is standard procedure for clergy accused of child abuse and the bishop will not be readmitted to

public ministry until it is completed. Speaking to *The Tablet* from Shanaglish, the bishop said that he was "utterly amazed" when he was told Ireland's Director of Public Prosecutions was dropping the charges.

Three weeks ago he was interviewed by Irish police for six hours about allegations made by a woman who alleged she was abused by him as a child. "I knew that it had to take its course," he said. "I never allowed it to interfere with me and if God wanted me to go through it, I would."
