This is a five-year, full-time contract post at the Department of Theology & Religious Studies endowed by the Irish Province of the Dominican Order.

The successful candidate will be actively involved in teaching and supervising research at the Department of TRS. Equally, s/he will be required to research in close collaboration with the staff of the Dominican Biblical Institute (DBI). S/he will need to have an openness to, and preferably experience of, research in biblical intertextuality. Areas of particular interest to the DBI at this time are: the adaptation of the Hebrew Scriptures/Old Testament in the New Testament; the literary relationships between biblical writings, especially within the New Testament; and the biblical writers' adaptation of non-biblical texts.
