Jesuit Post-Doctoral Fellowships at the Milltown Institute

The Irish Jesuits offer two post-doctoral fellowships for lay scholars at the Milltown Institute of Theology and Philosophy.

To be eligible for the fellowships, the applicant must be an Irish citizen and have recently completed a doctorate. The fellowships are for two years; there will be a review after the first year according to agreed criteria. Each fellowship offers an award of €30,000 per year. It offers a further €3,000 per year for travel/conferences. The duties of the scholars will be to teach one module per semester and by the end of the two years to have a work ready for publication, the topic of which must have the approval of the relevant Dean.

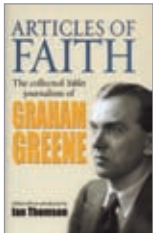

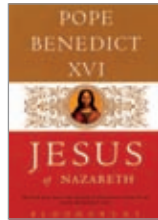

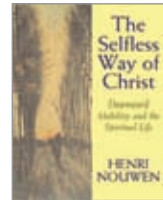
