The College is accredited by the Association of Theological Schools (ATS) in the United States and Canada and recognized by the Holy See as an Ecclesiastical Faculty for theological degrees.

The President will be required to exercise leadership in representing Regis in the Regis-University of St. Michael's College federation and to think strategically in the implementation of their memorandum of agreement. Inspired by Jesuit values and rooted in the Ignatian charism, the successful candidate will provide transformational vision and operational skills as a community builder to help the Regis community navigate the complexity of this new joint entity.

As the chief ambassador for the College, the President is an academic leader who is committed to a collaborative working style both within Regis and with the other schools of the TST.
